Strips 'N Curves Technique of Louisa L. Smith

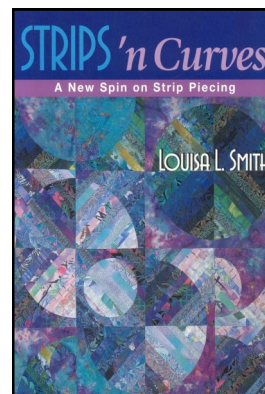

Next meeting: There is no regular meeting in August due to the county fair. Our next meeting is September 12.

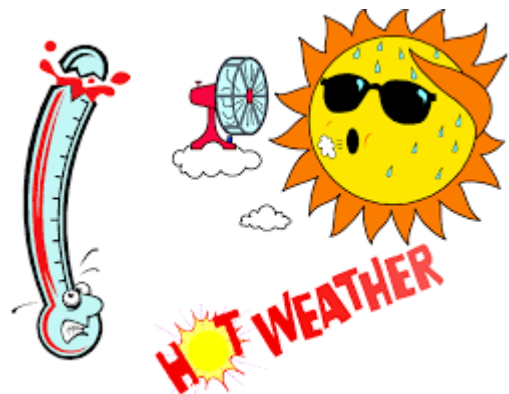
